Creative Art Workshops and Tours for Grades R – 9

The Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Art Museum will be running a visual art programme from January – December for school groups wishing to have an art experience at the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Art Museum. Educational programmes offered include school workshops and tours.

TOURS

Tours focusing on the Art Museum's Permanent Collection are available for the community, organizations, universities, colleges and school groups during opening hours. Entrance is free. Big groups are broken into smaller groups. Duration of tours: Foundation Phase: 30 minutes; Intermediate Phase: 45 minutes; Senior Phase: 60 minutes

Guided Tours

Co-ordinators or teachers who would like a guided tour for their group can contact the Art Museum to book the tour.

Self- Guided Tours

Co-ordinators or teachers are welcome to guide their students or group through the museum independently.

Special Request Tours

A special tour that meets the needs of the class can be arranged but must be made in writing well in advance.

SCHOOL LEARNER WORKSHOPS

Looking and learning through art: Learners can explore art and culture through the city's art collection and connect to visual arts, history, social sciences and literacy. Learners will be inspired to engage, explore and discover themes and stories created in art and will explore with a variety of art materials and techniques.

The school workshops are developed to make the most of the educational aspects of current exhibitions and are adapted for each grade. The workshops are free and presented on a Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday during a school term from 09h00 – 12h00. A minimum of 10 learners and a maximum of 30 learners can attend a workshop. A school can only book 4 workshops per term.
