In May 2016 the Friends purchased a mother of pearl blanket with beads for the value of R 7,470.

On the 22 June 2016 the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Art Museum celebrated its 60th anniversary. The exhibition **YEYETHU**, **SONKE** (**THIS BELONGS TO ALL OF US**): 60 **YEARS OF COLLECTING** was officially opened to the public of Nelson Mandela Bay. The Friends sponsored the refreshments. The Friends purchased artworks to the worth of R 60,000.

The committee also committed to purchasing 3 artworks by James Reed as a gift to the museum. They are "Coal dig with a flash in a 100 days" (Video), "Premonition" (Video), and "Suspended sentence" (Multimedia)

(Poetic Soul) who performed the famous poem Ukutshona Kukamendi (The Sinking of the Mendi) by S.E.K. Mghavi. Poet Brian Walter also performed a selection of poems from the collection entitled Mendi: Poems on the Sinking of the Mendi by Cathal Lagan, Basil Somhlahlo and Brian Walter published in 1994.

The Friends sponsored the refreshments, and paid for Prof. Graham's transport to travel to PE in order to attend the opening and

conduct the walkabouts and a workshop in February,
