Exhibition tours and art workshops are **FREE** and are held every: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 09h00 – 12h00. The workshops are developed to make the most of the educational aspects of current exhibitions and are adapted for each grade.

- Explore the Art Museum's collection
- Observe and talk about art
- Learn and explore art elements and design principles
- Develop learner's appreciation of art



## **12 OCTOBER – 9 DECEMBER 2022**

### **Learning to see through Drawing**

**Activity:** Observational drawing

#### **Grade R – 3**

*Explore with line, color, and shape.*

- Learners will identify the elements of art in the environment and in works of art, emphasizing line, color, and shape.

#### **Grade 4 – 6**

*Explore with line, shape, and space*

- Learners will explore various observational drawing skills to depict a variety of subject matter.
- Identify and describe all the elements of art found in selected works of art (color, shape/form, line, texture, space, value).
- Use the interaction between positive and negative space in their work of art.

#### **Grade 7 – 9**

*Explore with line, shape form, tone, texture, space, and proposition*

- Identify and describe the ways in which artists convey the illusion of space (e.g., placement, overlapping, relative size, atmospheric perspective, and linear perspective).
- Learners will use shading to transform a two-dimensional shape into what a three-dimensional form.
- Identify and describe scale (proportion) as applied to two-dimensional and three-dimensional works of art.

### **WORKSHOP BOOKINGS:**

**Please note:**

- ***Booking is essential!!***
- The school workshop programme works on a first come first serve basis.
- School educators should phone and book a workshop asap on 041 506 2000.
- A Minimum of 10 learners and a maximum of 20 learners can be accommodated in the workshop area.
- Workshops are free and are presented on a Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday during a school term from 09h00 – 12h00.
- The booking is only confirmed once you have received written correspondence from the Art Museum.
- The school is to arrange transport and learners are to bring their own packed lunches.
- A school may only book 4 workshops per term.

### **ART MUSEUM EXHIBITION GUIDED TOURS**

Educational tours of exhibitions are available for class groups. Coordinators or teachers who would like a guided tour for their group can contact the Art Museum to book the tour. Big groups are broken into smaller groups for the guided tours.

Duration of tours:

- Foundation Phase: 30 minutes
- Intermediate Phase: 45 minutes
- Senior Phase: 60 minutes

Coordinators or teachers are welcome to guide their students or group through the museum independently.
